

LIC COALITION'S VISION 2020 FOR ANABLE BASIN

- 1. Scrap existing plans for Anable Basin and replace them with a community-driven plan**
- 2. Create a continuous park along the river, extending north from Gantry State Park to Anable Basin and beyond, that would act as a sponge against storm surges and sea-level rise**
- 3. Maintain a minimum 200-foot-wide band of open space from the water's edge (floodplain) in order provide a buffer and meet required resiliency standards against sea level rise**
- 4. Keep publically owned properties (all land and buildings) public—in Anable Basin and throughout the community**
- 5. Arrange for the City and State to purchase privately owned properties that fall within the flood plain (such as “Lake Vernon”)**
- 6. Transfer Anable Basin public and private properties to a Community Land Trust**
- 7. Repurpose the DOE building (or its site) for two new middle schools, a community center, mentorship and tech training programs, small business and artist spaces, a community rooftop garden, and a ground floor atrium for a performance center and open market**
- 8. Create light manufacturing spaces in or around the DOE building**
- 9. Invest \$3 Billion of our city, state, and federal tax dollars in Long Island City to:**
 - a. Support the above proposals**
 - b. Fix infrastructure**
 - c. Bring NYCHA housing up to code**
